THE FOREST (SIND AMENDMENT) ACT, 1972.

[28th December, 1972]

An Act to amend the Forest Act, 1927, in its application to the Province of Sind.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Forest Act, 1927, in Preamble its application to the Province of Sind, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

- Forest(Sind Short title and 1. (1) called the This Act may be commencement Amendment) Act, 1972.
 - It shall be come into force at once. (2)
- In the Forest Act, 1927, in its application to the Province of Amendment of Sind, hereinafter referred to as the said act, in section 67, for the section 67 of Act words "Magistrate of the first class", the words "Special XVI of 1927 Executive Magistrate" shall be substituted.

In the said Act, in section 68 for sub-section (3) the Amendment of 3. following sub-section shall be substituted, namely:-

section 68 of Act XVI of 1927

- "(3) A Forest officer shall not be empowered under this section unless he is a Forest-officer of a rank not inferior to that of a Ranger, and the sum of money accepted as compensation under clause (a) of sub-section (1) shall in no case exceed the sum of five hundred rupees".
- In the said Act, for the cattles and amount of fines Amendment of 4. mentioned in section 71, the following shall be substituted, section 71 of Act namely:-

XVI of 1927

"For each Elephant Fifty rupees.

For each Camel Forty rupees.

For each Buffalo Twenty five rupees.

For each horse, mare, gelding

Pony, colt, filly, mule, bull, Bullock, cow, or heifer

Fifteen rupees.

For each calf, ass, ram, ewe.

Ten rupees."

Sheep, lamb, goat or kid.

THE FOREST (SIND AMENDMENT) ACT, 1972.

In the said Act, after section 79; the following new section Addition of 5. shall be added, namely:-

section 79-A to Act XVI of 1927

Requisition of police assistance

"79-A. If any Forest-officer authorized to take action under this Act requires police assistance in the exercise of his powers thereunder he may send requisition to the officer in charge of a police station who shall on such requisition render the assistance required".

The Forest (Sind Amendment) Ordinance, 1972, is hereby Repeal of Sind repealed.
