

THE SINDH REGISTRATION OF GODOWNS

RULES, 1996

Karachi, the 29th May, 1996

No. 20(30)SO(EXT) /95.—in exercise of the powers conferred by section 9 of the Sindh Registration of Godowns Act, 1996 the Government of Sindh are pleased to make the following rules.

1. These rules may be called the Sindh Registration of Godowns Rules 1996.
2. In these rules unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context.
 - i. “Certificate of registration” means a certificate issued under these rules.
 - ii. “Form” means a form appended to these.
 - iii. “Registration Fee” means fee payable under these rules.
3. An application for registration of a godown shall be made-by the owner in form-I.
4. The registering Authority or any other officer authorized by it in this behalf may in order to ensure the correctness of information contained in the application or furnished by the owner on demand make such enquiry as deemed fit.
5. If the owner furnishes incorrect information or fails to furnish the required information the application for registration shall be rejected.
6. Where an enquiry is made by any officer other than the Registering Authority itself, a report of the enquiry shall be submitted to the registering authority.
7. Where the Registering Authority registers A Godown, a certificate of registration shall be issued in form-II to the owner for the one year on payment of the fee not exceeding one thousand rupees as fixed by the Registering Authority with the approval of Government.
8. (i) Every certificate of registration shall be renewable before its expiry or latest within thirty days of the expiry on payment of the prescribed fee.
(ii) An application for renewing the certificate of registration shall be in form-III.
9. Every owner whose godown is registered shall maintain a stock register in form-IV and shall submit to Registering Authority a fortnightly return in respect of the essential articles stored or stocked in or removed from the registered godown in form-V.
