# THE NEWPORTS INSTITUTE OF COMMUNICATIONS AND ECONOMICS ORDINANCE, 2002.

[30<sup>th</sup> May, 2002]

AN Ordinance to provide for the establishment of an Institute at Karachi known as the Newports Institute of communications and Economics.

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to provide for the **Preamble** establishment of an Institute at Karachi known as the Newports Institute of Communications and Economics and to provide for matters ancillary thereto;

**AND WHEREAS** the Provincial Assembly stands dissolved in pursuance of the proclamation of the fourteenth day of October, 1999, and the Provisional Constitution Order No. 1 of 1999.

**AND WHEREAS** the Governor of Sindh is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in pursuance of the aforesaid Proclamation and the Provisional Constitution Order read with Provisional Constitution (Amendment) Order No. 9 of 1999, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

- 1. a. This Ordinance may be called the Newsports Institute of **Short title and** communications and Economics Ordinance, 2002. **commencement** 
  - b. It shall come into force at once.
- 2. In this Ordinance, unless there is anything repugnant in the **Definitions** subject or context
  - a. "Academic council" means the Academic Council of the Institute:
  - b. "Authority" means any Authority of the Institute;
  - c. "Board" means the Board of Governors of the Institute;
  - d. "Chairman" means the Chairman of the Board;
  - e. "Commission" means the University Grants

Commission;

- f. "Dean" means Dean of the faculty of the Institute;
- g. "Faculty" means Faculty of the institute;
- h. "Government" means the Government of Sindh;
- i. "Head" means Head of the Teaching Department of the institute:
- j. "Institute" means the Newports Institute of Communications and Economics;
- k. "Patron" means the Parton of the Institute;
- "Registrar" means the Registrar of the Institute;
- m. "Society means "The BASE Education Society", Karachi registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860, vide Certificate of Registration (KAR No. 069of 2000);
- n. "statutes" "regulations and rules" means statutes , regulations and rules respectively made under this Ordinance;
- o. "Teaching Department" means the Teaching Department established and maintained by the Institute:
- p. "teacher" means professor, Associate professor, Assistant professor and Lecturer engaged whole time by the Institute and includes such persons declared as such under this Ordinance:
- q. "Rector" means Rector of the Institute; and
- r. "Vice-Chairman" means the Vice-Chairman of the Board.
- 3. There shall be established at Karachi an Institute to be **Incorporation** called the Newports Institute of Communications and Economics consisting of
  - i. the members of such councils, committees and other bodies as the Board may establish;

- ii. the teachers and students of the Institute and its constituent units:
- iii. the Chairman, the Vice-Chairman, the Deans and other members of the Board; and
- iv. such other officers and members of the staff as may from time to time be specified by the Board.
- b. The Institute shall be a body corporate by the name of the Newports Institute of Communications and Economics having perpetual succession and a common seal, with power, among others, to acquire, hold and dispose of any property or investments and shall the said by the name sue and be sued.
- 4. (1) The Institute shall have the powers-

Powers and functions of the Newports Institute

- a. to provide for instructions and training in such Newports Institute branches of learning as it may deem fit, and to make provision for research, demonstration and other services, and for the advancement and dissemination of knowledge;
- b. to admit and examine students;
- to hold examinations and confer or award degrees, diplomas, certificates and other academic distinctions on and to persons who have passed its examinations under the prescribed conditions;
- d. to select and promote faculties;
- e. to confer honorary degrees;
- f. to prescribed courses of studies in such branches of learning as the Institute may determine;
- g. to pursue research;
- h. to establish and support other facilities for education, training and research;
- i. to enter into agreements, contacts and arrangements with universities, organizations, institutions, bodies and individuals for the purpose

of carrying out its functions and activities;

- to decide teaching methods and strategies in į. order to ensure the most effective educational and training programmes;
- k. to demand and receive such fees and other charges as it may determine, provided that ten percent of the students will be granted freeship or financial support on the basis of need cum merit.
- (2) The powers and functions under subsection (1) shall be exercised and performed subject to general Control and directions of the Government.
- 5. The Institute shall be open to persons of either sex of The Institute shall whatever religion, race, creed, colour or domicile who are be open to all academically qualified for admission to the courses of study classes, creeds offered by the Institute, and no such person shall be deemed etc. the privileges of the Institute on the ground of sex, religion creed, race, class colonies domicile.

6. a. The academic programmes of the Institute including **Teaching and** teaching and examination shall be conducted in the examinations in prescribed manner.

- The Institute shall associate external examiners for the b. conduct of examinations.
- No degree shall be granted unless a student has passed an examination in Islamic Studies and Pakistan Studies at the Bachelor's degree level or, in the case of a non-Muslim student, in Ethics and Pakistan Studies as his or her option.
- In prescribing syllabi, courses of studies and instructions d. for the conduct of studies, the Institute shall abide by the directions given from time to time by Government.

7. The following shall be the Authorities of the Institute:- Authorities of the Institute

- 8. The following shall be the officers of the Institute:-

Officers of the institute

- a. The Chairman;
- b. the Rector:
- c. the Deans;
- d. the Heads of the Teaching Department;
- e. the Registrar; and
- such other persons as may be specified by regulations to be the officers.
- 9. The Governor Sindh shall be the patron of the Patron a. Institute.
  - The patron, shall when present, preside at the b. convocation of the Institute.
  - Every proposal to confer an honorary degree shall be c. subject to confirmation by the patron.
- 10. The patron may cause an inspection or inquiry to be **Visitation** a. made on his own motion in respect of any matter connected with the affairs of the Institute and shall from time to time, direct any person or persons to inquire or carry out inspection of-

- the Institute, its buildings, laboratories, libraries and i. other facilities:
- ii. any institute, department or hostel maintained by the Institute:
- iii. the adequacy of financial and human resources of the institute:
- iv. the teaching, research, curriculum, examination and other matters of the Institute; and

- v. such other matters as may specified by him.
- b. The Patron shall communicate to the Board his views with regard to the results of the visitation and shall, after ascertaining the views of the Board advise the Board on the action to be taken by it.
- c. The Board shall, within such time as may be specified by the Patron, communicate to him such action, if any, as has been taken or may be proposed to be taken upon the results of visitation.
- d. Where the Board does not, within the time specified, take action to the satisfaction of the patron, the patron may issue such directions as he deems fit and the Board shall comply with all such directions.
- e. The Patron shall have full powers to take any action, as he may deem fit against the Institute, including withdrawal of charter and its closure.
- 11. a. The chairman shall be appointed by the Patron from **Chairman** a panel recommended by the Society for a period of four years.
  - b. The Vice Chairman shall be appointed by the Chairman on the recommendation of the Board on such terms and conditions as may be prescribed.
  - c. The Chairman shall in the absence of the Patron preside at the convocation.
  - d. If the Chairman is satisfied that the proceedings of any Authority or orders of any officer are not in accordance with the provision of this Ordinance, the statutes, the regulations or the rules, he may, after calling upon such Authority or officer to show cause why such proceedings should not be annulled, by order in writing, annul such proceedings or orders.
  - e. The Chairman may remove any person from the membership of any Authority if such person
    - i. has become of un sound mind; or
    - ii. has been incapacitated to function as member of such Authority; or

- has been convicted by court of law for an iii. offence involving moral turpitude or has been found indulging in any activity against the interest of the Institute:
- iv. should the Chairman be incapacitated from acting as such due to absence or any other cause, the Vice-Chairman or nominee of the Chairman shall act for him.
- The Rector shall be an eminent scholar of national or Terms and 12. a. international repute and an educationist of distinction conditions of and shall be appointed by the Chairman on the appointment of recommendation of the Board for a period of Four Rector vears on such terms and conditions as the Board may determine.

- b. Rector shall be the chief academic and administrative officer of the Institute and shall be responsible for the implementation of the decision of the Board and for the execution of the programme of the institute in accordance with the guidelines and policies formulated by the Board.
- The Rector shall also have powers-C.
  - to submit plans of work and budget estimates i. of the Institute to the Board for consideration and approval;
  - to direct the activities connected with the ii. execution of programmes for instructions, training, research, services to the community.
  - to authorize expenditure provided for in the iii. approved budget and to re-appropriate funds within the same major head of expenditure and report it to the Board in the next meeting.
  - to sanction and re-appropriate and amount iv. not exceeding one lac rupees for a unforeseen item not provided for in the budget and report it to the Board in the next meeting
  - to appoint, with the approval of the Board, of ٧. the teachers, officers and members of the staff

of the Institute and such other persons as may be necessary in accordance with policies and procedures approved by the Board so as to ensure the highest intellectual and moral qualities in the persons appointed;

- vi. to submit to the Board, in accordance with the rules of procedure, reports on the activities of the Institute and the execution of the plans of work;
- vii. to create temporary posts for a period not exceeding six months; and
- viii. to undertake any work assigned by the Board.
- 13. a. The Board shall consist of the following-

- i. the Chairman:
- ii. a judge of the High Court or Sindh nominated by the Chief justice;
- iii. Chairman of the Commission or his nominee:
- iv. Secretary Education or his nominee not below not below the rank of an Additional Secretary;
- v. three nominees of the Society;
- vi. Chairman, Chamber of Commerce and Industry or his nominee;
- vii. one scientist of national or international repute nominated by the Board;
- viii. the Rector, who shall be the member and Secretary of the Board;
- b. The members of the Board other than ex-officio members shall hold office for a period of three years;
- c. No act or proceedings of the Board shall be invalid by reasons only of the existence of a vacancy in, or any defect in the constitution of the Board.

14. The Board shall exercise the power and perform the **Powers** functions as follows:-

- Powers and functions of the Board
- i. to hold, control and administer the property, funds and resources of the Institute and raise funds for the purpose of the Institute upon such security as may be required under regulations;
- ii. to undertake responsibility for the financial viability of the Institute including responsibility for ensuring effectiveness of its operations their continuity and preservation of the autonomy of the Institute;
- iii. to consider and pass the resolution of the annual report, plan of work statement of accounts and the annual budget estimates;
- iv. to formulate or approve the principle, polices and plans governing the activities and operations of the Institute so as to facilitate research teaching and other academic work:
- v. to make statutes and approve rules and regulations;
- vi. to have prepared and revised from time to time rules and regulations for the efficient and effective operation of the Institute;
- vii. to create a component of the Institute such as faculties, departments and institutes under its jurisdiction and to constitute such standing committees, councils and other administrative or academic advisory bodies as it deems necessary, and review their work:
- viii. to approve plans of work and annual budget of the Institute;
- ix. to call for and consider reports relating to the activities of the Institute and the execution of the plans of work and to direct the Rector to furnish information relating to any matter specified by the Board;
- to create such academic or administrative posts as it may deem necessary and to approve appointment to such posts;

- xi. constitute committees or sub-committees as it may deem necessary;
- to take all such initiatives as it may consider xii. necessary for the efficient and effective management and functioning of the Institute;
- to appoint teachers and other employees on the xiii. recommendation of the Selection Board: and
- to delegate its powers to an authority or officer xiv. including the Rector or a Committee.
- The Board shall meet at least twice a year on the Meetings of the a. fixed by the Vice-Chairman, with Board dates to be approval, of chairmen provided that a special meeting may be called at any time by the Chairman or on the request by not less than five members of the Board to consider any matter of urgent nature;

- b. In the case of a special meeting not less than ten clear days' notice shall be given to the members of the Board, and the agenda of the meeting shall be restricted to the matter for which the special meeting is called:
- The quorum for a meeting of the Board shall be one C. half of its members, fraction being counted as one.
- The decisions of the Board shall be expressed in terms d. of the views of the majority and voting of the members present and if the members are equally divided, the Chairman shall have the power exercise a castina vote.
- The academic and administrative staff of the Institutes shall **Academic and** 16. be selected with a view to achieving its objectives and the Administrative basic criteria for their selection shall be the Highers staff standards of competence, integrity and efficiency;

Provided that in the case of academic staff, academic qualification and fringe benefit shall not be less than those approved or laid down by the Commission for such staff.

17. The Institute shall have a fund to which shall be Institute fund. a. trusts. audit and credited income from fees, donations. bequests, endowments, grants, contribution and any accounts other source.

- b. No contribution, donation or grant, which may directly or indirectly involve any immediate or subsequent finical liability of the Institute or which may involve and activity not included in its programmes for the time being shall be accepted without the prior approval of the Board.
- c. The accounts of the Institute shall be maintained in such form and in such manner as may be prescribed by rules.
- d. The accounts of the Institute shall be audited each year within four months of the closing of the financial year by a Chartered Accountant appointed by the Board.
- e. The accounts, together with the report of the auditor thereon, shall be submitted to the Board for approval.
- f. The auditor's report shall certify that the auditor has complied with the standards of audit and certification laid down by the institute of Chartered Accountants of Pakistan.
- 18. a. The Academic Council shall consist of-

  - to prescribe the course of studies, the syllabi vii. and the outlines of test for all examinations subject to the approval of the Board;
