**NOTIFICATION**

Karachi, dated the 20<sup>th</sup> June, 1981.

NO. SOIX-REG(S&GAD)II/23-80.— In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 read with section 10 of the Sind Public Service Commission Ordinance, 1978, the Government of Sind are pleased to make the following rules; namely:-

**PART-I-GENERAL**

1. (1) These rules may be called the Sind Public Service Commission (Conditions of Service) Rules, 1981. **Short title and commencement.**  
(2) They shall come into force at once.
2. The Chairman shall receive pay in [<sup>1</sup>Basic Pay Scale ] **Pay.**  
22 and a member in <sup>2</sup>[Basic Pay Scale] 20.  
Provided that if the Chairman or member—  
(a) immediately before his such appointment was in service of Pakistan and was drawing higher pay, he shall continue to draw such pay;  
(b) is re-employed after retirement from the service of Pakistan his pay shall be regulated in accordance with the instructions and rules as if he is re-employed in a post under Government.

Provided that Chairman or a member who was

immediately before his such appointment in a grade below grade 20 of the Basic Pay Scale shall continue to draw pay in that grade plus a special pay of Rs. 440.00 per month, subject to the condition that the aggregate of his pay and special pay shall not exceed the maximum pay in grade-20.

3. The Chairman shall be entitled to free unfurnished residential accommodation for the term of his office and fifteen days after ceasing to hold the office. **Residential Accommodation.**
4. Chairman or a Member shall be entitled to the use of official car on such conditions, as are applicable in the case of use of official car by a Secretary to Government. **Staff Car.**
5. The service as Chairman or Member shall not qualify for pension except that the Chairman or Member, who immediately before his such appointment was in service of Pakistan, in whose case such service shall count for pension. **Pension.**
6. (1) Chairman or a member may, if he so chooses, subscribe to the General Provident Fund in accordance with the rules applicable to a civil servant. **Provident Fund.**  
  
(2) Chairman or a Member who immediately before his appointment as member was in service of Pakistan and was subscribing to the Provident Fund, shall continue to subscribe to the said Fund on the same terms and conditions:  
Provided that he shall cease to subscribe to the Fund on attaining the age of superannuation in his previous service.
7. (1) Chairman or a Member, who immediately before his such appointment was in service of Pakistan shall be granted leave in accordance with the rules applicable to him before the said appointment and his service as Chairman or Member shall count for such leave. **Leave.**  
  
(2) Chairman or a Member, whose case is not covered by sub-rule (1) shall be granted leave as follows:-

- (a) leave— On leave salary equivalent to full pay upto one eleventh of the period spent on duty as Chairman or Member, subject to a maximum of four months at any one time;
- (b) leave ex-Pakistan or leave on medical certificate on leave salary equivalent to half pay upto 1/12<sup>th</sup> (one twelveth) of the period spent on duty as Chairman or a member, subject to the maximum of three months at any one time; and
- (c) extra-ordinary-leave without salary for any period.

Explanation.— A person who is appointed as Chairman or a Member after his retirement from the service in Pakistan or who attains the age of superannuation while serving in the Commission as Chairman or Member, shall be governed by this rule.

### **PART III- TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE AND MEDICAL ALLOWANCE**

- 8. For the purpose of Travelling Allowance, Chairman or a Member shall be entitled to the allowances admissible to a Secretary to Government. **Travelling Allowance.**
  - 9. Chairman or a Member shall be entitled to the medical facilities admissible in terms of the West Pakistan Government Servants (Medical Attendance) Rules, 1959 as amended from time to time. **Medical Allowance.**
- Provided that the Chairman or Member, who, immediately before his appointment as Chairman or member was in service of Pakistan may elect to be governed by the rules applicable to him before such.
- 10. The Sind Public Service Commission (Conditions of Service) Rules, 1974 are hereby rescinded. **Repeal.**
