THE MILITARY COURTS (VALIDATION OF ORDERS) ORDINANCE, 1980
SINDH ORDINANCE NO. I OF 1980

An Ordinance to validate certain orders passed by Military Courts under Martial Law Order No.20.

WHEREAS it is expedient to validate certain orders passed by Military Courts under Martial Law Order No.20 made by the Martial Law Administrator Zone 'C'; **Preamble.**

NOW THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977 and the Laws (Continuance in Force) Order, 1977, the Governor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Military Courts (Validation of Orders) Ordinance, 1980. **Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. (1) Notwithstanding any order, judgment or decision of any court, an order passed by a Military Court at any time on or after the sixteenth day of August, 1977, in any proceedings under Martial Law Order No.20 made by the Martial Law Administrator Zone 'C' shall be deemed to have been passed under the Sindh Rented Premises Ordinance, 1979, as if the said Ordinance were in force at the time when such order was passed and shall have, and shall be deemed always to have had, effect accordingly. **Validation of certain orders etc.**

(2) Any person aggrieved by any such order as is referred to in subsection (1) may, within thirty days of the commencement of this Ordinance, prefer an appeal to the High Court.
