

SINDH ORDINANCE NO.XIV OF 1980

THE SIND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (SECOND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1980

[15th October, 1980]

An Ordinance to amend the Sind Local Government Ordinance, 1979.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Local Government Ordinance, 1979, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

Preamble.

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977 and the Laws (Continuance in Force) Order, 1977, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Local Government (Second Amendment) Ordinance, 1980.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once and shall be deemed to have taken effect on and from the 25th day of July, 1979.

2. In the Sind Local Government Ordinance, 1979, in section 51, for sub-section (11), the following shall be substituted:-

Amendment of Section 51 of Sind Ordinance XII of 1979.

“(11) (a) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Ordinance, Government may, by notification disqualify any member who has acted in contravention of the provisions of sub-section (10) without given him an opportunity of being heard and such member shall, from the date of the notification, cease to be the member of the council.

(b) The member disqualified under clause (a) may, within sixty days of the notification, make representation to Government for review of the order of his disqualification and Government may, after giving him an opportunity of being heard, make such order, as it deems fit”.
