

**SIND ORDINANCE NO. IV OF 1981**  
**THE SIND COTTON CONTROL (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1981**

[9<sup>th</sup> March , 1981]

**An Ordinance** to amend the Sindh Cotton Control Ordinance, 1966.

**WHEREAS**, it is expedient to amend the Sind Cotton Control Ordinance, 1966, in the manner hereinafter appearing; **Preamble.**

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977 and the Laws (Continuance in Force) Order, 1977, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Cotton Control (Amendment) Ordinance, 1981. **Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Cotton Control Ordinance, 1966, hereinafter called as the said Ordinance— **General amendments in West Pakistan Ordinance XX of 1966.**

(a) for the word “Advisory Committees”, wherever occurring, the words “Cotton Committees”, shall be substituted;

(b) for the words “Extra Assistant Director of Agriculture”, wherever occurring, the words “ Assistant Director of Agriculture” shall be substituted.

(c) for the words “Cotton Control Board”, wherever occurring, the words “Sind Cotton Board” shall be substituted.

3. In the said Ordinance, in section 2— **Amendment of Section 2 of West Pakistan Ordinance XX of 1966.**

(i) Clause (b) shall be omitted;

(ii) After clause (e), the following clause shall be inserted:—

“(ee) ‘Cotton Committee’ means a Cotton Committee constituted under section 3.”.
