Karachi, the 27th May, 1989.

No. PAS/Legis-B-4/89.—The Sindh Government Servants Benevolent Fund (Amendment) Bill, 1989 having been passed by the Provincial Assembly of Sindh on 9th April, 1989 and assented to by the Governor of Sindh on 4th May, 1989 is hereby published as an Act of the Legislature of Sindh.

THE SINDH GOVERNMENT SERVANTS BENEVOLENT FUND (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1989

SINDH ACT NO. IX OF 1989

(First published after having received the assent of the Governor of Sindh in the Gazette of Sindh (Extra-Ordinary) dated 27th May, 1989.)

AN

ACT

to amend the Sindh Government Servants Benevolent Fund Ordinance, 1960

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sindh Government Servants Benevolent Fund Ordinance, 1960, in the manner hereinafter appearing; Preamble.

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Sindh Government Servants Benevolent Fund (Amendment) Act, 1989.

2. In the Sindh Government Servants Benevolent Fund Ordinance, 1960, hereinafter referred to as the said Ordinance, in section 2—

(i) for clause (a), the following shall be substituted :—

“(a) “family” in relation to a Government servant means—

(i) wife or wives in the case of male and husband in the case of a female; and

(ii) the legitimate and step children, below twenty one years, parents, minor brothers, and unmarried, divorced or widowed sisters, wholly dependent upon him or her;”;

(ii) clauses (c) and (f) shall be omitted.

3. In the said Ordinance, in section 3—

(i) sub-section (2) shall be omitted;

(ii) in sub-section (3), for the words “Each part of the” the word “The” shall be substituted.

4. In the said Ordinance, in section 4, in clause(a), after sub-clause (iii), the following shall be added :—

“(iv) making housing schemes for the serving Government servants and the families of the Government servants in the event of their death while in service;”;

5. (1) In the said Ordinance, for section 6, the following shall be substituted :—

“6. Boards of Management.

(1) As soon as may be, Government shall, in such manner as may be prescribed, constitute the following Boards of Management, namely :—

(a) the Provincial Board of Management;

(b) the Divisional Board of Management for each Division; and

(c) the Secretariat Board of Management;

(2) Subject to such directions as may be issued by Government and such rules as may be made in this behalf—

(a) the Provincial Board of Management shall have the powers to—

(i) invest moneys credited to the Fund;

(ii) incur expenditure from the Fund;

- (iii) allocate funds to the Divisional and Secretariat Boards of Management; and
- (iv) constitute a committee for providing relief from the Fund to Government servants holding posts in Basic Pay Scale 16 and above and their families;
- (b) a Divisional Board of Management shall subject to such directions as may be issued by the Provincial Board of Management—
 - (i) deal with all matters connected with the Fund allocated to it;
 - (ii) provide relief to the Government servants holding posts in Basic Pay Scale 1 to Basic Pay Scale 15 in their respective Divisions and sanction expenditure;
- (c) the Secretariat Board of Management shall subject to such directions as may be issued by the Provincial Board of Management—
 - (i) deal with all matters connected with the Fund allocated to it;
 - (ii) provide relief to the Government servants holding posts in Basic Pay Scale 1 to Basic Pay Scale 15 and sanction expenditure.”.

6. In the said Ordinance, in section 6-A, for the words “any such Board” the words “the Board” shall be substituted.
