Karachi, the 3rd June, 1987

No. PAS/Legis-B-5/87.—The Sind Local Government (Amendment) Bill, 1987 having been passed by the Provincial Assembly of Sind on 30th April, 1987 and assented to by the Governor of Sind on 25th May, 1987 is hereby published as an Act of the Legislature of Sind.

THE SIND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1987

SIND ACT NO. IV OF 1987

(First published after having received the assent of the Governor of Sind in the Gazette of Sind (Extra-Ordinary) dated 3rd June, 1987).

ACT

to amend the Sind Local Government Ordinance, 1979.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Local Government Preamble. Ordinance, 1979, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows: -

1. (1) This Act may be called the Sind Local Government (Amend- Short title ment) Act, 1987.

- (2) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. In the Sind Local Government Ordinance, 1979, hereinafter referred to as the said Ordinance, in section 10, in the proviso to sub-section (2), the fullstop at the end shall be replaced by a colon and thereafter the following provisos shall be added:-

Amendment section 10 Ordinance XII of 1979.

"Provided further that on supersession of a council under section 58, the person or authority appointed to perform the functions of such council may appoint any member of the Advisory Committee appointed under section 58-A or where no such Committee is appointed any other person to exercise the powers and perform the functions of the Chairman of one or more Panchayats.

Provided also that a Chairman of Panchayat for a minority community shall be a member of the minority community.".

Insertion of section 58-A in Sind Ordinance XII of 1979.

- 3. In the said Ordinance, after section 58, the following new section shall be inserted:—
- "58-A. (1) Where any person or authority is appointed under sub-section (2) of section 58, Government may appoint an Advisory Committee consisting of such number of persons as it thinks fit to advise such person or authority.
- (2) The Advisory Committee shall meet as often and in such manner as the person or authority deems fit.
- (3) A member of the Advisory Committee shall hold office at the pleasure of Government but may at any time resign from member-ship by addressing letter to Government.".

Repeal of Sind Ordinance I of 1987. 4. The Sind Local Government (Amendment) Ordinance, 1987, is hereby repealed.
