THE SIND COTTON CONTROL (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1984.

Sind Ordinance No. XXXIII of 1984.

AN

ORDINANCE

to amend the Sind Cotton Control Ordinance, 1966.

WHEREAS the Federal Shariat Court has directed to make certain Preamble. amendments in the law relating to cotton control;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Cotton Control Ordinance, 1966, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, and the Provisional Constitution Order 1981, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

Short title and commencement.

- 1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Cotton Control (Amendment) Ordinance, 1984.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment of section 7 of West Pakistan Ordinance XX of 1966.

- 2. In the Sind Cotton Control Ordinance, 1966, in section 7, after subsection (3), the following new sub-section shall be inserted:—
 - "(3-A) Any person aggrieved by an order passed under sub-section (3) may, within seven days of the order, prefer an appeal to Government, whose decision shall be final:

Provided that no order shall be passed in appeal unless the appellant has been afforded an opportunity of being heard.
