No. PAS/Legis-B-12/85.—The Sind Speaker's and Deputy Speaker's (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) (Amendment) Bill, 1985 having been passed by the Provincial Assembly of Sind on 18th December, 1985 and assented to by the Governor of Sind on 31st December, 1985 is hereby published as an Act of the Legislature of Sind.

THE SIND SPEAKER'S AND DEPUTY SPEAKER'S (SALARIES, ALLOWANCES AND PRIVILEGES) (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1985

SIND ACT No. XI OF 1985

(First published after having received the assent of the Governor of Sind in the Gazette of Sind (Extra-Ordinary) dated 8th January, 1986.

AN

ACT

to amend the Sind Speaker's and Deputy Speaker's (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Speaker's and Deputy Speaker's (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Sind Speaker's and Deputy Speaker's (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) (Amendment) Act, 1985.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once and shall be deemed to have taken effect on and from the date the first Speaker has assumed the office after the tenth day of March, 1985.

2. In the Sind Speaker's and Deputy Speaker's (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975, hereinafter referred to as the said Act, after section 3, the following new section shall be inserted:—

Insertion of section 3-A in Sind Act VII of 1975.

3 A Equipment Allowance

The Speaker or the Deputy Speaker shall, on his first election as such, receive an equipment allowance of three thousand rupees and two thousand rupees, respectively:

Provided that the equipment allowance shall not be drawn if an allowance for the same purpose has been drawn previously upon his appointment or election to the office of Chief Minister, Minister, Speaker or Deputy Speaker during the tenure of the Assembly for which he has been elected as Speaker or Deputy Speaker.”.

Amendment of section 5 of Sind Act VII of 1975.

3. In the said Act, in section 5, for the words “three thousand rupees and two thousand rupees”, the words “five thousand rupees and four thousand rupees” shall be substituted.

Amendment of section 6 of Sind Act VII of 1975.

4. In the said Act, in section 6—

(a) in sub-section (1)—

(i) for the words “fifteen thousand rupees”, the words “fifty thousand rupees” shall be substituted;

(ii) for the words “ten thousand rupees” the words “twenty five thousand rupees” shall be substituted;

(b) for sub-section (2), the following shall be substituted:—

“(2) Where the Speaker or Deputy Speaker is not provided with an official residence or prefers to reside in a private residence, he shall, respectively, be paid eight thousand rupees or seven thousand rupees per mensem in the case of his own house or the actual rent incurred by him subject, respectively, to a maximum of eight thousand rupees or seven thousand rupees per mensem in the case of a rented house, and The Speaker shall, in addition, be paid a sum of twenty thousand rupees for furnishing the house only once whether he is appointed as Minister or elected as Speaker, for any number of occasions either during the first tenure of the Assembly after the tenth day of March, 1985, or on election of a new Assembly.

(2-A) The quality of the material provided in an official residence shall be in accord with the decision of a Committee consisting of the Chief Secretary, Finance Secretary and the Secretary Communications and Works Department.”.

5. In the said Act, in section 8, for the words "five hundred rupees and three hundred rupees", the words "three thousand rupees and one thousand and five hundred rupees" shall be substituted.

6. In the said Act, in section 10, in sub-section (1), for the words "one hundred rupees and seventy five rupees", the words "one hundred and twenty five rupees" shall be substituted.
