## PROVINCIAL ASSEMBLY OF SIND NOTIFICATION.

Karachi, the 28th June 1976

No. PAS/Legis/Bill-11/76.—The Sind Finance Bill, 1976 having been passed by the Provincial Assembly of Sind on the 25th June, 1976 and assented to by the Governor of Sind on 28th June, 1976 is hereby published as an Act of the Legislature of Sind: -

## THE SIND FINANCE ACT, 1976

SIND ACT No. IX OF 1976

(First published after having received the assent of the Governor of Sind in the Gazette of Sind (Extra-ordinary), dated the 28th June, 1976).

AN

ACT

to rationalize, levy and enhance certain taxes and fees in the Province of Sind.

WHEREAS it is expedient to rationalize, levy and enhance certain Preamble. taxes and fees in the Province of Sind;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Sind Finance Act, 1976.
  - (2) It shall come into force on and from 1st day of July, 1976.

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Amendment of West Pakistan Act V of 1958.

- 2. In the Sind Urban Immovable Property Tax Act, 1958-
  - (i) in section 3, for the Explanation below sub-section (3-B), the following shall be substituted: -

"Explanation.—For the purpose of this sub-section, independent vacant plot means a plot on which no building has been raised within three years of its possession to the allottee in respect of the plot transferred by allotment, and to the person entitled to receive the possession in respect of the plot transferred otherwise.";

### (ii) in section 4—

- (a) in clause (c), for the words "five hundred", the words "seven hundred and fifty" and for the words "four hundred", the wodrs "six hundred" shall be substituted;
- (b) in clause (g), for the words "one thousand", the words "one thousand and five hundred" shall be substituted.

Amendment of West Pakistan Act XXXII of 1958.

- 3. In the Sind Motor Vehicles Taxation Act, 1958, in the Schedule, in entry 5, for item (c), the following shall be substituted:-
  - "(c) Seating not more than four persons and of-
    - .... Rs. 240 (i) not more than 10 Horse Power ...
  - (ii) more than 10 Horse Power but less than 18 Horse Power
  - ... Rs. 400.". (iii) 18 Horse Power and above

Amendment of West Pakistan Act XXXVIII of 1958.

4. In the Sind Tobacco Vend Act, 1958, for section 3, the following shall be substituted-

Prohibition manufactured tobacco without licence: dealer's licence.

"3. No person shall keep for retail sale or sell by retail, against dealing in manufactured tobacco in any urban area without a dealer's

> Provided that no licence shall be required by a hawker or a person who grows tobacco himself or with the aid of the members of his family or tenants or hired labour.".

- In the Sind Finance Act, 1964-
  - (i) in section 11, in sub-section (1), for the figures "44", the figures "78" shall be substituted;
  - (ii) in the Seventh Schedule-
    - (a) in entry 15, in column 2, for the word "two", the word "three" shall be substituted;
    - (b) after entry 44, entries 45 to 78 mentioned in the Schedule shall be added.



Amendment of West Pakistan Act XXXIV of 1964. WI THE

6. In the Sind Cotton Control Ordinance, 1966, after section 30, the Amendment following new section shall be added: -

Pakistan Ordinance XX of 1966.

default in payment of fees under section 30(2)(1).

"31. Where the fee prescribed under clause (1) of subsection (2) of section 30 is not paid within the prescribed period, the prescribed authority may, in the absence of sufficient cause for non-payment of such fee, impose a penalty not exceeding the amount of the fee.".
