No. PAS/Legis./B-2/74.—The West Pakistan Foodstuffs (Control) (Sind Amendment) Bill, 1974, having been passed by the Provincial Assembly of Sind on the 6th March, 1974, and assented to by the Governor of Sind on the 16th March, 1974 is hereby published as an Act of the Legislature of Sind: -

THE WEST PAKISTAN FOODSTUFFS (CONTROL) (SIND AMENDMENT) ACT, 1974.

SIND ACT No. I OF 1974

(First published after having received the assent of the Governor of Sind in the Gazette of Sind (Extra Ordinary) dated 16th March, 1974).

AN

ACT

to further amend the West Pakistan Foodstuffs (Control) Act, 1958, in its application to the Province of Sind.

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend the West Pakistan Food- Preamble. stuffs (Control) Act, 1958, in its application to the Province of Sind, in the manner hereinafter appearing.

It is hereby enacted as follows: -

Short title and Commencement.

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the West Pakistan Foodstuffs (Control) (Sind Amendment) Act, 1974.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment of section 9 of West Pakistan Act XX of 1958.

- 2. In the West Pakistan Foodstuffs (Control) Act, 1958, in its application to the Province of Sind, section 9 shall be numbered as sub-section (1) of that section, and thereafter the following shall be added as sub-section (2), namely:—
 - "(2) Any officer or official of the Food Department who issues or attempts to issue or abets the issuing of a ration document which he knows or has reason to believe to be bogus, shall be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to three years or with fine or with both."

Repeal of Sind Ordinance XV of 1973. 3. The West Pakistan Foodstuffs (Control) (Sind Second Amendment) Ordinance, 1973, is hereby repealed.
