

## PROVINCIAL ASSEMBLY OF SIND

## NOTIFICATION

Karachi, dated the 28th June, 1973.

No. PAS/Legis-B-6/73.—The Sind People's Local Government (Amendment) Bill, 1973 having been passed by the Provincial Assembly of Sind on the 6th June, 1973 and assented to by the Governor of Sind on the 27th June, 1973 is hereby published as an Act of the Legislature of Sind:—

THE SIND PEOPLE'S LOCAL GOVERNMENT (AMENDMENT) ACT,  
1973.

(First published after having received the assent of the Governor of Sind in the Gazette of Sind (Extra Ordinary) dated 28th June, 1973).

ACT

*to amend the Sind People's Local Government Ordinance, 1972.*

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind People's Local Government Ordinance, 1972, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

Short title and commencement.

1. (1) This Act may be called the Sind People's Local Government (Amendment) Act, 1973.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment of section 100 of Sind Ordinance II of 1972.

2. In the Sind People's Local Government Ordinance, 1972, hereinafter referred to as the said Ordinance, in section 100, in sub-section (1), for the words "a fine which may extend to five hundred rupees", the words "imprisonment of either description for a term which may extend to three months or with fine which may extend to one thousand rupees or with both" shall be substituted.

3. In Schedule X to the said Ordinance, after entry 35, the following new entries shall be added, namely :—

X to Sind  
Ordinance II  
of 1972.

• “35-A. Writing or painting of any objectionable, abusive, provocative or such other slogans or words on a building.

35-B. Failure to remove or erase bills, notices, placards, papers, writings or paintings referred to in entries 35 and 35-A by the owner or occupier of the building.”.

4. The Sind People's Local Government (Amendment) Ordinance, 1973, is hereby repealed.
