## NOTIFICATION

Karachi, dated the 28th December, 1972.

No. PAS/Legis-B-23/72.—The West Pakistan Prevention of Gambling (Sind Amendment) Bill, 1972 having been passed by the Provincial Assembly of Sind on the 23rd December, 1972 and assented to by the Governor of Sind on the 28th December, 1972 is hereby published as an Act of the Legislature of Sind:—

THE WEST PAKISTAN PREVENTION OF GAMBLING (SIND AMENDMENT) ACT, 1972.

Sind Act No. XXIII of 1972.

(First published after having received the assent of the Governor of Sind in the Gazette of Sind (Extra Ordinary) dated the 28th December, 1972).

AN

ACT

*to amend the West Pakistan Prevention of Gambling Ordinance, 1961, in its application to the Province of Sind.*

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the West Pakistan Prevention of Gambling Ordinance, 1961, in its application to the Province of Sind, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

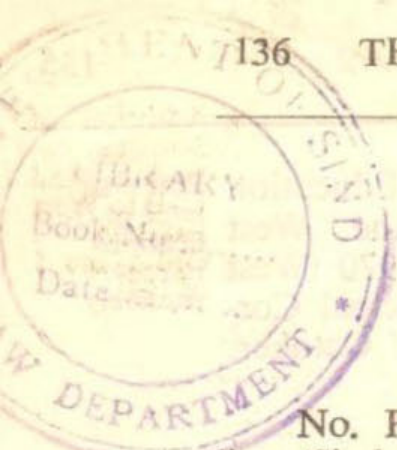
1. (1) This Act may be called the West Pakistan Prevention of Gambling (Sind Amendment) Act, 1972.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the West Pakistan Prevention of Gambling Ordinance, 1961, in its application to the Province of Sind, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, in section 2, after the word "skill", the words and comma "or games played in a Tourist Complex established, maintained and run under a licence" shall be added.

3. In section 3 of the Principal Ordinance, the full stop at the end of clause (e) shall be replaced by a semi-colon and the word "and", and thereafter the following new clauses shall be added:—

"(f) 'Tourist Complex' means a private building or part thereof used for musical or theatrical performances, entertainments and playing of various games for foreigners;"

4. After section 11 of the Principal Ordinance, the following new sections shall be added, namely:—

Addition of Sections 11-A and 11-B to West Pakistan Ordinance I of 1961.

“11-A. Government may issue a licence for establishing, maintaining, and running of a Tourist Complex on such conditions as may be prescribed.

11-B. Government may make rules for carrying into effect, the provisions of this Ordinance, and in particular for—

- (a) prescribing conditions for grant of licence for Tourist Complex;
- (b) regulating admission to the Tourist Complex;
- (c) operation of various games to be played in the Tourist Complex.”

5 The West Pakistan Prevention of Gambling (Sind Amendment) Ordinance, 1972, is hereby repealed.
