Karachi, the 19th April, 1975

No. PAS/Legis/Bill-7/75.—The Abkari Laws (Sind Amendment) Bill, 1975 having been passed by the Provincial Assembly of Sind on the 4th April, 1975 and assented to by the Governor of Sind on 16th April, 1975 is hereby published as an Act of the Legislature of Sind:—

THE ABKARI LAWS (SIND AMENDMENT) ACT, 1975.

(First published after having received the assent of the Governor of Sind in the Gazette of Sind (Extra-ordinary) dated the 19th April, 1975.

AN

ACT

to further amend the Sind Abkari Act, 1878, the Sind Consumption of Intoxicants Restriction Act, 1940 and the West Pakistan Prohibition of Opium Smoking Ordinance, 1960.

WHEREAS it is expedient to further amend the Sind Abkari Act, 1878, the Sind Consumption of Intoxicants Restriction Act, 1940 and the West Pakistan Prohibition of Opium Smoking Ordinance, 1960, in the manner hereinafter appearing; Preamble.

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

Short title
and com-
mencement.

1. (1) This Act may be called the Abkari Laws (Sind Amendment) Act, 1975.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment.

2. The laws specified in column 2 of the Schedule are hereby amended to the extent and in the manner mentioned in column 3 thereof.

In section 43—</p> <p>(a) in sub-section (1), for the words “three years or with fine which may extend to five thousand rupees or with both”, the words “seven years or with fine which may extend to one lac rupees or with both” shall be substituted ;</p> <p>(b) in sub-section (2), for the words “five years and fine which may extend to seven thousand rupees”, the words “seven years and fine which may extend to one lac rupees” shall be substituted;</p> <p>(c) in sub-section (3), for the words “five years and fine which may extend to seven thousand rupees”, the words “seven years and fine which may extend to one lac rupees” shall be substituted.</p> <p>2. In section 46, for the words and commas “seven thousand rupees, or with imprisonment which may extend to five years, or with both”, the words and commas “one lac rupees, or with imprisonment which may extend to seven years, or with both” shall be substituted.</p> <p>3. 2. The Sind Consumption of Intoxicants Restriction Act, 1940 (Sind Act IV of 1940)

3. The West Pakistan Prohibition of Opium Smoking Ordinance, 1960 (West Pakistan Ordinance 2 of 1960) as applicable to the Province of Sind.

“one lac rupees, or with imprisonment for a term which may extend to seven years, or with both” shall be substituted ; and

4. In section 55-A, in the proviso, for the words “five thousand rupees”, the words “one lac rupees” shall be substituted.

1. In sections 3, 4 and 5.—

(a) for the words “three years or with fine which may extend to five thousand rupees”, the words “seven years or with fine which may extend to one lac rupees” shall be substituted ; and

(b) for the words “five years or with fine which may extend to seven thousand rupees”, the words “seven years or with fine which may extend to one lac rupees” shall be substituted.

2. In section 23, in sub-section (1), for the words and figures “Rs. 200.00”, the words “one lac rupees” shall be substituted.”.

1. In section 4, for the words “five years or with fine which may extend to seven thousand rupees or with both” the words “seven years or with fine which may extend to one lac rupees or with both” shall be substituted.

2. In section 5, for the words “simple or rigorous imprisonment for a term which may extend to five years or with fine which may extend to seven thousand rupees or with both”, the words “simple or rigorous imprisonment for a term which may extend to seven years or with fine which may extend to one lac rupees or with both” shall be substituted.

3. In section 6 for the words and commas "five years, or with fine which may extend to seven thousand rupees, or with both", the words "seven years or with fine which may extend to one lac rupees, or with both" shall be substituted.
