[THE CATTLE-TRESPASS (SIND AMENDMENT) ACT, 1931.]

[23rd May, 1931].

An Act further to amend the Cattle-trespass Act, 1871, in its application to the [Province of Sind].

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Cattle-Lot trespass Act, 1871, in its application to the '[Province of Sind], in manner hereinafter appearing; It is hereby enacted as follows:—

 This Act may be called the Cattle-trespass (3[Sind] Amend-Short title, ment) Act, 1931.

2. In the proviso to section 14 of the Cattle-trespass Act, 1871, Amendment of the words "Magistrate of the District" the words "officer authoof Act I of rised to sell them by public auction" shall be substituted.
