[THE INDUS VESSELS ACT, 1863.]

[2nd February, 1863.]

An Act for the registry of vessels 28 the River Indus.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the registry of vessels plying on the river Indus and its tidal channels within the '[Sind]

It is enacted as follows: -

Vessels to Every vessel plying on the river Indus and its tidal channels be registered within '[Sind] shall be registered by an officer appointed for the and marked with number, purpose, who shall be called the Registrar of boats, and every vessel burthen and so registered shall be marked or branded with a number, the registerindication of ed burthen and a letter or letters indicating the place of registry. place of registry.

Name. number. burthen, etc., to be registered.

The name and number and burthen of every vessel plying as aforesaid, and the name of the owner thereof, shall be registered in a book kept for that purpose by the Registrar of boats; and whenever any change shall take place in the burthen of such vessel plying as aforesaid, or in the name or names of the owner thereof, such vessel shall be again registered.

Owner to apply for certificate of registry. Renewalot lost certificate.

The owner of every vessel plying as aforesaid shall apply to the Registrar of boats and obtain from him a certificate of registry as aforesaid; and in the case of any certificate being lost or destroved, a renewed certificate may be obtained in the same manner and on the payment of the fees hereinafter mentioned.

Fees for registeration.

4. The owner of every vessel registered as aforesaid shall annually or otherwise pay such 'fees as the 'Provincial Governmentl may, from time to time, direct by notification in the "Cofficial Gazette].

- The owner or person in charge of every vessel plying as Production aforesaid shall produce, when required by any public officer, the cate of certificate of registry of such vessel.
- In case any vessel plying as aforesaid shall not be registered, Penalty for marked or branded, in all respects as hereinbefore directed, or

in case such vessel shall not be furnished with a proper certificate of registry, or

in case the owner or person in charge of such vessel shall not produce such certificate when required as aforesaid,

the owner or person in charge of such vessel shall, on conviction thereof before a Magistrate [of the first class], be liable to a fine not exceeding ten times the amount of the fees payable annually in respect of the registry of such vessel, which fine, if not paid, may be recovered by sale of such vessel, her furniture, ammunition, tackle and apparel.
