An Act further to amend the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals
Act, 1890,

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1890, in its application to "Isind in manner hereinafter appearing; It is hereby enacted as follows:—

Short 1. This Act may be called the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals ([Sindl Amendment) Act. 1923.

XI of 2. In section II of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, Amendment 1890, 1890, after the words "offence to" the words "abandon, turn loose of XI or" shall be insered.
