[THE PRESS AND REGISTRATION OF BOOKS (SIND AMENDMENT)
ACT, 1949.]

[12th May, 1949]

*An Act to amend the Press and Registration of Books Act, 1867,
in its application to the Province of Sind.*

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Press and Registration of Books Act, 1867, in its application to the Province of Sind, for the purpose hereinafter appearing: It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Press and Registration of Books (Sind Amendment) Act, 1949. Short title.

2. For section IIA of the Press and Registration of Books Act, 1867, the following shall be substituted, namely:— Amendment
of Section
IIA of Act
XXV of 1867.

“IIA. The printer of every newspaper in the Province of Sind shall deliver at such place and to such officer as the Provincial Government may, by notification in the *Official Gazette*, direct, and free of expense to the Government, five copies of each issue of such newspaper as soon as it is published.”
