*An Act to amend the Muslim Personal Law (Shariat) Application Act, 1937.*

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Muslim Personal Law (Shariat) Application Act, 1937, in its application to the Province of Sind for the purpose hereinafter appearing; It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. This Act may be called the Muslim Personal Law (Shariat) Application (Sind Amendment) Act, 1950.

2. In section 1 of the Muslim Personal Law (Shariat) Application Act, 1937 (hereinafter called the said Act), after sub-section (2) the following new sub-section shall be inserted, namely :—

“(3) The provisions of this Act, except section 3 and sub-section (2) of section 4, shall apply to all the Muslim inhabitants of the Province of Sind.”

3. In section 2 of the said Act the words and brackets “(save questions relating to agricultural land)” and “(other than charities and charitable institutions and charitable and religious endowments)” shall be omitted.
