

SIND ACT No. XII OF 1938<sup>1</sup>.

[THE STAMP (SIND AMENDMENT) ACT, 1938.]

[9th June 1938].

An Act to amend the <sup>2\*</sup> Stamp Act, 1899.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the <sup>2\*</sup> Stamp Act, 1899, in its application to the Province of Sind, for the purpose hereinafter appearing ; It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be called the <sup>3\*</sup> Stamp (Sind Amendment) Act, 1938.

Short title, extent and commencement.

(2) It extends to the whole of the Province of Sind.

(3) It shall come into force at once.

2. In Schedule I to the <sup>2\*</sup> Stamp Act, 1899, in the entry in column 1 against Article 57, after the word "thereof" the words " or executed in favour of a court for the due discharge of a contingent liability " shall be inserted.
