SINDH BILL NO. 04 OF 2014.

to amend the Sindh Service Tribunals Act, 1973. WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sindh Preamble. Service Tribunals Act,1973, in the manner hereinafter appearing:

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

1. (1) This Act may be called the Sindh Service Tribunals Short title and (Amendment) Act, 2014.

- (2) It shall come into force at once and shall be deemed to have taken effect on and from 7th August, 2013.
- In the Sindh Service Tribunals Act, 1973, in Amendment of section 3, for sub-sections (3) and (4), the following shall section 3 of Sind be substituted:-

- "(3) A Tribunal shall consist of a Chairman and two Members, who shall be appointed by Government in consultation with the Chief Justice, High Court of Sindh, for a period not more than three years for one time only.
- (4) (i) A person who has been or is qualified to be a Judge of the High Court, shall be eligible for appointment as Chairman.
 - (ii) two members, one of whom shall be

another shall be appointed from amongst the sitting civil servants in BS-20, preferably having legal background, for a period of not more than three years for one time only or till the date of his superannuation, whichever is earlier.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

In compliance to the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of Pakistan vide judgment dated 25-03-2013 in C.P.No. 53 of 2007 and C.P.No. 83 of 2012, the amendment in the composition of Tribunal in section 3 has been made. The object of this amendment is to strengthen the independent working of the Sindh Service Tribunals, therefore, it is expedient to make suitable amendment in the Sindh Service Tribunals Act, 1973

The Bill seeks to achieve the above object.
