SINDH BILL NO. 07 OF 2014.

BILL

to amend the Sindh Civil Servants (Regularization of Adhoc Appointment) Act, 1994.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sindh Civil Servants (Regularization of Adhoc Appointment) Act,1994, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows :-

This Act may be called the Sindh Civil Servants Short title and 1. (1) (Regularization of Adhoc Appointments) (Amendment) Act, 2014.

commencement.

- It shall come into force at once and shall be deemed to have taken effect on and from 28th July, 1994.
- In the Sindh Civil Servants (Regularization of Adhoc Appointments), 1994, in section 3, in sub-section (1), in the last line, for the words " the date of the commencement of this Act", the words "the date of his initial appointment" shall be substituted.

Amendment of section 3 of Sindh Act XIX of 1994.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The Civil servants who were working on adhoc basis, their previous services were not regularized, the working efficiency and normal service benefits in the matter of promotion and confirmations enjoyed by their colleagues who were junior to these civil servants by virtue of date of appointment. To remove the hardship made on the basis of discrimination, to double standards, injustice, hardship and to enable them to enjoying all service benefit it is competent to allow regularization and seniority.

The Bill seeks to achieve the above object.
