THE SINDH CIVIL SERVANTS (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2014.

SINDH BILL NO. 29 OF 2014.

BILL

to amend the Sindh Civil Servants Act, 1973.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sindh Civil Preamble. Servants Act, 1973, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

1. (1) This Act may be called the Sindh Civil Servants Short title and (Amendment) Act, 2014.

- (2) It shall come into force at once.
- In the Sindh Civil Servants Act, 1973, after section Insertion of 23-B, the following shall be inserted:-

section 23-C in Sindh Act No.XIV of 1973.

- "23-C. Appointment of Federal Civil Servants. (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, Government may, by notification, appoint a person to a civil service of the Province or to a post in connection with the affairs of the Province, who immediately before the commencement of the Constitution (Eighteenth Amendment) Act, 2010 (Act No. X of 2010) was holding a post in connection with the affairs of the Federation and whose services have been transferred to the Province in the wake of the said Amendment Act of 2010.
- (2) Government shall, in prescribed manner, determine the terms and conditions of service of the civil servants appointed under sub-section (1) including cadre and seniority.".

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS.

In order to give status of civil servants in Sindh to the regular employees of devolved entities of the Federal Government who were transferred on deputation basis in the wake of Constitution (Eighteenth Amendment) Act 2010 (Act No.X of 2010), it is expedient to amend the Sindh Civil Servants Act, 1973.

The Bill seeks to achieve the above object.
