AN

ORDINANCE

to amend the West Pakistan Historical Mosques and Shrines Fund Cess Ordinance, 1960, in its application to the Province of Sind.

Preamble

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the West Pakistan Historical Mosques and Shrines Fund Cess Ordinance, 1960, in its application to the Province of Sind, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Martial Law Proclamation of 25th March, 1969, read with the Provisional Constitution Order, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Sind and Martial Law Administrator, Zone 'D', is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

Short title.

- 1. This Ordinance may be called the West Pakistan Historical Mosques and Shrines Fund Cess (Sind Amendment) Ordinance, 1971.
- Amendment
 2. In the West Pakistan Historical Mosques and Shrines Fund Cess of section 3 of Ordinance, 1960, in its application to the Province of Sind, in sub-section (4) of section 3, for the word "eleven", the word "twelve" shall be substituted, and shall be deemed to have been so substituted with effect from 30th September, 1970.
