SIND ORDINANCE No. XIII OF 1970

THE CIVIL COURTS (SIND) AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1970.

[21st December, 1970]

An Ordinance to amend the Karachi Courts Order, 1956, and the West Pakistan civil Courts Ordinance, 1962.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Karachi Court Preamble. Order, 1956, and the West Pakistan Civil Courts Ordinance, 1962, in the manner herein-after appearing;

in pursuance of the Martial Law Short title and NOW THEREFORE, Proclamation of 25th March, 1969, read with the Provisional commencement Constitution Order, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

- 1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Civil Courts (Sindh Amendment) Ordinance, 1970.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. In the Karachi Courts Order, 1956, in Article 4, for the Amendment of existing clause (2), the following clause shall be Article 4 of P.O. substituted, namely:-

The Court of the District Judge, Karachi, shall 1956 not have jurisdiction in original civil suits and proceedings wherein the subject matter exceeds fifty thousand rupees.".

3. In the West Pakistan Civil Court Ordinance, 1962, in Amendment of section 24, in the proviso to sub-section (1) and in section 24 of W.P. sub-section (2-A), for the words "twenty-five Ordinance 11 of thousand", wherever occurring, the words "fifty 1962 thousand" shall be substituted.
