KARACHI, THE 10TH APRIL, 2015.

NO.PAS/Legis-B-20/2014-The Sindh Allopathic System (Prevention of unauthorized use) Bill, 2014 having been passed by the Provincial Assembly of Sindh on 19th November, 2014 and assented to by the Governor of Sindh on 8th April, 2015 is hereby published as an Act of the Legislature of Sindh.

THE SINDH ALLOPATHIC SYSTEM (PREVENTION OF UNAUTHORIZED USE) ACT, 2014.

SINDH ACT NO. XVIII OF 2015.

to prevent unauthorized use of allopathic system of medicine and to provide for matters connected therewith.

WHEREAS it is expedient to prevent unauthorized use Preamble. of Allopathic system of medicine and to provide for matters connected therewith;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

Short title and commencement.

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Sindh Allopathic System (Prevention of **Unauthorized use**) Act, 2014.
 - (2) It shall extend to the whole of the Province of Sindh.
 - (3) It shall come into force at once.

Definition.

- 2. In this Act, unless there is anything repugnant in the subject or context -
 - (i) "Government" means the Government of Sindh;
 - (ii) "Ordinance" means the Pakistan Medical and Dental Council Ordinance, 1962;
 - (iii) "registered medical practitioner" means a person registered under the Ordinance.

Prohibition of the use of the word doctor and it variation, etc.

3. No person practicing the allopathic, homeopathic, ayurvedic, unani or any other system of medicine shall use with his name or address or with the name or address of his business the word "doctor" or any of its grammatical variation, cognate expressions or abbreviations so as to give out that he is entitled to practice medicine unless he is a registered medical practitioner:

Provided that nothing in this section shall apply to a person on whom a Doctor's degree other than medical degree has been conferred by any university in or outside Pakistan.

Prohibition of the use of the medical degree or diplomas.

4. No person shall use a medical degree or a medical diploma to give out that he is a qualified medical practitioner or for any purpose connected with medical practice, unless such degree or diploma has been conferred or awarded by a university or institution in or outside the Pakistan recognized under the Ordinance.

Prohibition of performing surgical operations by unqualified persons.

5. No person other than a registered medical practitioner shall perform any surgical operation other than circumcision, incision of boils and administration of injections.

Prohibition of prescribing certain drugs.

6. No person other than a registered medical practitioner or a person authorized in this behalf by Government shall prescribe any antibiotic or dangerous drug specified in the rules under this Act.

No person shall sell in the market any patent or proprietory medicine of the unani, ayurvedic, homeopathic, biochemist or allopathic system of medicine unless there is displayed, in a conspicuous and readily intelligible manner; on the label or container thereof and also on the outer cover of the container (other than ordinary wrapper), the true formula of the medicine contained in it.

Restriction on the sale of patent and propriety medicines.

8. Government may, by notification in the official gazette, make rules for carrying out the purposes of this Act.

Power to make rules.

Whoever contravenes the provisions of this Act shall be Penalty. punishable with imprisonment which may extend to one year or . with fine not exceeding one hundred thousand rupees or with both.

10. (1) No prosecution shall be instituted under this Act except Jurisdiction. by an Inspector appointed under the Drugs Act, 1976 (XXIII of 1976) or by a person specially empowered by Government in this behalf.

- (2) No Court inferior to that of a Magistrate of the First Class shall try an offence punishable under this Act.
- No suit or any other legal proceedings shall lie against Protection. any Inspector or person acting in good faith under section 10 of this Act.
