THE SIND INDUSTRIAL TRADING ESTATE RECOVERY OF DUES ORDINANCE, 1973

[12th May, 1973]

An Ordinance to provide for recovery of the dues of the Sind Industrial Trading Estate.

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for recovery of the **Preamble**. dues of the Sind Industrial Trading Estate;

AND WHEREAS the Provincial Assembly of Sind is not in session and the Governor of Sind is satisfied that circumstance exist which render immediate action necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 135 of the Interim Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance: -

1.(1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind IndustrialShort title extentTrading Estate Recovery of Dues Ordinance, 1973.andcommencement.

(2) It extends to the whole Province of Sind.

(3) It shall come into force at once.

2. In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires, **Definitions.** the following expressions shall have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say—

- (a) "defaulter" means a person from whom any dues are recoverable by the Sind Industrial Trading Estate and includes a person who is responsible as surety for payment of any such dues;
- (b) "Government" means the Government of Sind; and
- (c) "Sind Industrial Trading Estate" means the Sind Industrial Trading Estate Company created under Sind Government Resolution No.24-I.B/47-1, dated 2nd June, 1947.

3. (1) Government may by notification declare that any **Declaration of** dues or class of dues recoverable by Sind Industrial Trading Estate shall be recoverable from defaulters as if such dues were the arrears of land-revenue.

(2) On publication of the notification under sub-section(1) any such dues shall be recoverable under the RevenueRecovery Act, 1890 (Act I of 1890) as arrears of land-revenue.
