THE COURT FEES (SIND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1984

An Ordinance to amend the Court-fees Act, 1870 in its application to the Province of Sind.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Court Fees Act, 1870, in its application to the Province of Sind, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

Preamble.

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, and the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sind is please to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:

(1) This Ordinance may be called the Court-Fees Short title (Sind Amendment) Ordinance, 1984.

 - (b) Certificate under Part X of the Succession Act, 1925.
 - (c) Certificate under the Sind Regulation VIII of 1827".
