THE REFORMATORY SCHOOLS (SIND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1984

[3rd September, 1984]

An Ordinance to amend the Reformator Schools Act, 1897.

Preamble. WHEREAS the Federal Shariat Court has directed to make certain amendments in the Reformatory Schools Act, 1897;

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Reformatory Schools Act, 1897, in its application to the Province of Sind, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, and the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

(1) This Ordinance may be called the Reformatory Short title and Schools (Sind Amendment) Ordinance, 1984.
