

**SIND ORDINANCE NO.XIX OF 1984**

**THE SIND ABKARI (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1984**

[27<sup>th</sup> September, 1984]

**An Ordinance** to amend the Sind Abkari Act, 1878.

**WHEREAS** the Federal Shariat Court has directed to make certain amendments in the Sind Abkari Act, 1878; **Preamble.**

**AND WHEREAS** it is expedient to amend the Sind Abkari Act, 1878, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977 and the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Abkari (Amendment) Ordinance, 1984.

**Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Abkari Act, 1878, hereinafter referred to as the said Act, in Part VII, after section 32-C, the following shall be inserted: —

**Insertion of section 32-D in Sind Act V of 1878.**

**Restriction to issuance of licence pass or permit to Muslims.**

“32-D. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, no licence, permit or pass shall be issued to a Muslim except for a purpose for which a licence is issuable under article 17 of the Prohibition (Enforcement of Hadd) Order, 1979.”.

3. In the said Act, in Part XI, after section 60-A, the following shall be inserted:—

**Insertion of section 60-B in Sind Act V of 1878.**

**Opportunity of hearing on appeal or revision.**

60-B. No order, in appeal or revision under the foregoing provisions, shall be passed unless the person likely to be affected thereby has been given an opportunity of being heard.”.
