An Ordinance to amend the Sind Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975	
WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Ministers (Salaries Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975, in the manner hereinafter appearing;	Preamble.
NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977 and the Provincial Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :-	
 (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1983. 	
(2) It shall come into force at once and shall be deemed to have taken effect on and from 1st January, 1983.	
2. In the Sind Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975, hereinafter referred to as the Said Act, after section 3, the following shall be inserted I—	
Equipment allowance "3-A. A Minister shall, on his first appointment, be entitled to equipment allowance of three thousand rupees."	
3. In the said Act, in section 5, for the word "shall respectively be three thousand rupees and two thousand five hundred rupees per mensem" the words "shall be three thousand rupees per mensem" shall be substituted.	section 5 of Sind
4. In the said Act, in section 6, for the words "one thousand rupees" the words "one thousand and five hundred rupees" shall be substituted.	
5. In the said Act, after section 6, the following shall be inserted:-	Insertion of section 6-A in Sind Act VIII of 1975.
Discretionary Grant "6-A A Minister may in his discretion make grants to the extent of seven thousand and five hundred rupees in a year."	1775.
