

**SIND ORDINANCE NO.XXVII OF 1984.**

**THE SIND IRRIGATION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1984**

[30<sup>th</sup> September, 1984]

**An Ordinance** to amend the Sind Irrigation Act, 1879.

**WHEREAS** the Federal Shariat Court has directed to make certain amendments in the Sind Irrigation Act, 1879; **Preamble.**

**AND WHEREAS** it is expedient to amend the Sind Irrigation Act, 1879, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, and the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Irrigation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1984. **Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Irrigation Act, 1879, hereinafter referred to as the said Act, in section 36, the fullstop at the end shall be replaced by a colon and thereafter the following proviso shall be added:- **Amendment of section 36 of Sind Act VII of 1879.**

“Provided that no appeal shall be decided unless the appellants has been afforded an opportunity of being heard.”.

3. In the said Act, in section 40, for the words “at twelve times” the words “at not less than fifteen times and not more than twenty times” shall be substituted. **Amendment of section 40 of Sind Act VII of 1879.**
