SIND ORDINANCE NO.XLII OF 1984

THE POLICE (SIND SECOND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1984

[15th November, 1984]

An Ordinance to amend the Police Act, 1861, in its application to the Province of Sind.

WHEREAS It is expedient to amend the Police Act, 1861, Preamble. in its application to the Province of Sind, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fifth day of July, 1977, and the Provisional Constitution Order, 1981, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

- This Ordinance may be called the Police Short title and 1. (Sind Second Amendment) Ordinance, 1984.

 - (2)It is shall come into force at once.
- In the Police Act, 1861, in its application to the **Amendment of** 2. province of Sind, in section 30, in the proviso to sub-section (3), section 30 of Act the fullstop at the end shall be replaced by a colon and V of 1861. thereafter the following new proviso shall be added:-

"Provided further that he shall refuse to grant a licence in a case in which the Magistrate of the or of the sub-division of a district is district satisfied and conveys such satisfaction to him in writing that the grant of the licence is likely to cause a breach of the peace or to be prejudicial to the public safety or public interest or the maintenance of public order.".
