

SIND ACT NO.III OF 1987

THE SIND SMALL INDUSTRIES CORPORATION (AMENDMENT) ACT, 1987

[26th March, 1987]

An Act to amend the Sind Small Industries Corporation Act, 1972

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Small Industries Corporation Act, 1972, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

Preamble.

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Sind Small Industries Corporation (Amendment) Act, 1987.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Small Industries Corporation Act, 1972, in section 2, for clause (n), the following shall be substituted: —

Amendment of section 2 of Sind Act No.XXVI of 1972.

“(n) “small industry” means an industry including cottage industry engaged in the handicrafts or manufacture of consumer or producer goods involving fixed capital investment (including land and buildings) the original value of which does not exceed ten million rupees or the amount as may from time to time, be fixed by Government by notification in the Official Gazette.”.
