THE SINDH INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY BOARD, ORDINANCE, 1999

[31st May, 1999]

to provide for the establishment of a Board of Information Technology in the Province of Sindh.

WHEREAS it is expedient to provide for the establishment of **Preamble** a Board of information Technology in the Province of Sindh and matters connected therewith or ancillary thereto;

AND WHEREAS the Provincial Assembly is not in session and the Governor of Sindh is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 128 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:--

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sindh InformationShort title and
commencement.Technology Board Ordinance, 1999.commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In this Ordinance, unless there is anything repugnant in **Definitions**. the subject or context—

- (a) "Board" means the Board established under section 3;
- (b) "Chairman" means the Chairman of the Board;
- (c) "Government" means the Government of Sind;
- (d) "Prescribed" means prescribed by rules or regulations
- (e) "regulations" means regulations made under this Ordinance;
- (f) "rules" means rules mad under this Ordinance;

3. (1) The Government may establish a Board to be called **Incorporation**. the Sindh Information Technology Board.

(2) The Board shall be a body corporate having perpetual succession and a common seal with power to acquire, hold and dispose of property and shall by the said name sue and be sued.

4. (1) The Board shall consist of Chairman and such **Constitution of** number of members as may be appointed by Government. **the Board.**

(2) The Chairman shall be appointed by Government on such terms and conditions as it may determine.

(3) A member of the Board shall hold office at the pleasure of Government.

(4) A member may at any time by writing under his hand resign from his office by addressing a letter to Government.

(5) The Board may coopt any person as a member for any particular purpose but such person shall not have right of vote.

(6) No act, proceedings or decision of the Board shall be invalid by reason of any vacancy or defect in the constitution of the Board.

5. (1) The Board shall take all such measures and exercise Functions and such powers as it deems necessary for carrying out the purposes of the board.

(2) Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing powers, the Board may-

(a) Promote or develop, use of information technology;

- (b) Formulate and enforce any scheme for the purpose of this Ordinance;
- (c) Procure necessary equipment for its proper functioning;

(2) The fund shall be kept in such custody and shall be utilized and regulated in such manner as may be prescribed by rules.

11. The budget of the Board shall be prepared, approved **Budget**, **audit** and its accounts shall be maintained and audited in such **and accounts**. manner as may be prescribed by rules.

12. (1) Government may at any time require the Board to **Power of** furnish to it any document, returns, statement, statistics or any **Government to** other information regarding any matter, under the control of the **give direction**. Board and the Board shall comply with such requisition.

(2) Government may from time to time give such directions as it considers necessary for the guidance of and compliance by the Board.

13. The Board shall, soon after expiry of each financial year, **Annual report.** furnish an annual report to Government on the conduct of its affairs for that year.

14. Government may make rules for carrying out the purposes **Rules** of this Ordinance.

15. Subject to this ordinance and rules the Board may make **Regulations** regulations for carrying out the purposes of this Ordinance.
