

SINDH ORDINANCE NO. VI of 2001

THE SINDH WILDLIFE PROTECTION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 2001.

[20th January 2001]

An Ordinance to amend the Sindh Wildlife Protection Ordinance 1972.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sindh Wildlife Protection Ordinance, 1972, in the manner hereinafter appearing; **Preamble.**

AND WHEREAS the Provincial Assembly stands suspended in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fourteenth day of October, 1999, and the Provisional Constitution Order No. 1 of 1999;

AND WHEREAS the Governor of Sindh is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREAFORE, in pursuance of the aforesaid Proclamation and the Provisional Constitution Order read with Provisional Constitution (Amendment) Order No. 9 of 1999, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Wildlife Protection (Amendment) Ordinance, 2001. **Short title, and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sindh Wildlife Protection Ordinance, 1972, hereinafter referred to as the said Ordinance, in section 14, in sub-section (3), in the proviso, the full stop at the end shall be replaced by colon and thereafter the following new proviso shall be added:- [Amendment of section 14 of Sindh Ordinance V of 1972.](#)

“Provided further that Government may authorize the laying of an underground pipeline, using construction techniques other than blasting, which do not permanently disturb the wildlife or environment, on such terms and conditions including the betterment, conservation and preservation of the wildlife sanctuary, as may be specified.”

3. In the said Ordinance, in section 15, in sub-section (4), in the proviso the full stop at the end shall be replaced by colon and thereafter the following new proviso shall be added:- [Amendment of section 15 of Sindh Ordinance No. V of 1972](#)

“Provided further that Government may authorize the laying of an underground pipeline, using construction techniques other than blasting, which do not permanently disturb the wildlife or environment, on such terms and conditions, including the betterment, conservation and preservation of the national park as may be specified.”

4. In the said Ordinance, in section 17, for the words “one thousand” and “five hundred”, the words “ten thousand” and “five thousand” shall be substituted respectively.
