#### THE PROVINCIAL MOTOR VEHICLES (SIND AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1976

[26<sup>th</sup> October, 1976]

An Ordinance further to amend the Provincial Motor Vehicles Ordinance, 1965, in its application to the Province of Sind.

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Provincial Preamble. Motor Vehicles Ordinance, 1965, in its application to the Province of Sind, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

**AND WHEREAS** the Provincial Assembly is not in session and the Governor of Sind is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 128 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Provincial Motor Short title and Vehicles (Sind Amendment) Ordinance, 1976.

- 19. Any injury which endangers life or which causes
  1,500
  the sufferer to be, during the space of twenty
  days in sever bodily pain, or unable to follow his
  ordinary pursuit.
- 20. Medical expenses for any injury not specified in Actual expenses certified by a Medical Officer.

Note:-- Maximum compensation payable for more than one injury shall be limited to rupees ten thousand.".
