

**SINDH ORDINANCE NO. XXXIII OF 2002**

**THE SINDH LOCAL GOVERNMENT (SIXTH AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 2002.**

[08<sup>TH</sup> October, 2002.]

**AN ORDINANCE** to further amend the Sindh Local Government Ordinance, 2001.

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to amend the Sindh Local Government Ordinance, 2001, in the manner hereinafter appearing; **Preamble.**

**AND WHEREAS** the Provincial Assembly stands dissolved in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fourteenth day of October, 1999, and the Provincial Constitution Order No. 1 of 1999.

**AND WHEREAS** the Governor of Sindh is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in pursuance of the aforesaid Proclamation and the Provisional Constitution Order read with Provisional Constitution (Amendment) Order No. 9 of 1999, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sindh Local Government (Sixth Amendment) Ordinance, 2002. **Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sindh Local Government Ordinance, 2001, in section 159, in sub-section (1), for the word “three” the word “four” shall be substituted. [Amendment of section 159 of Sindh Ordinance No. XXVII of 2001.](#)
