## SINDH ORDINANCE NO. XXXIX OF 2002

## THE SINDH SPEAKER'S AND DEPUTY SPEAKER'S (SALARIES, ALLOWANCES AND PRIVILEGES) (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 2002.

[21<sup>ST</sup> October, 2002.]

**AN ORDINANCE** to amend the Sindh Speaker's and Deputy Speaker's (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975.

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to amend the Sindh Speaker' and Deputy **Preamble.** Speaker's (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

**AND WHEREAS** the Provincial Assembly stands dissolved in pursuance of the Proclamation of the fourteenth day of October, 1999, and the Provincial Constitution Order No. 1 of 1999.

**AND WHEREAS** the Governor of Sindh is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in pursuance of the aforesaid Proclamation and the Provisional Constitution Order read with Provisional Constitution (Amendment) Order No. 9 of 1999, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the Governor of Sindh is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

1. (i) This Ordinance may be called The Sindh Speaker's and Deputy Speaker's (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) (Amendment) Ordinance, 2002.

Short title, and commencement.

- (ii) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. In the Sindh Speaker's and Deputy Speaker's (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975, hereinafter referred to as the said Act, in section 5, for the words "Twenty thousand two hundred and fifty rupees and eighteen thousand", the words "thirty thousand and five hundred twenty seven thousand rupees" shall respectively be substituted.

Amendment of section of Sindh Act No. VII of 1975.

3. In the said Act, in section 6, for sub-section (2), the following shall be substituted:-

"(2) Where the Speaker or Deputy Speaker is not provided with an official residence or prefers to reside in his own house or a private residence, he shall respectively, be paid thirty nine thousand and five hundred rupees and thirty five thousand rupees per mensem, and shall, in addition, be paid a sum of sixty thousand rupees for furnishing the house only once whether he is appointed as Minister of or elected as Speaker or Deputy Speaker for any number of occasions either during the first tenure of the Assembly after tenth day of March, 1985, or on election of a new Assembly."
