THE N.E.D.UNIVERSITY OF ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1986.

[30TH July ,1986.]

An ordinance to amend the N.E.D. University of Engineering and Technology Act, 1977.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the N.E.D. **Preamble.** University of Engineering and Technology Act, 1977, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the Provincial Assembly is not in session and the Governor of Sind is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 128 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance:-

- This Ordinance may be called the N.E.D. University of Short title and Engineering and Technology (Amendment) commencement. Ordinance, 1986.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. In the N.E.D. University of Engineering and Amendment of Technology Act, 1977, hereinafter referred to as the said section 2 of Sind Act, in section 2, after clause (m), the following shall be inserted:

"(mm) "Pro-Vice-Chancellor" means the Pro Voice Chancellor of the University;".

3. In the said Act, in section 15, in sub-section (1), after Amendment clause (i), the following shall be inserted:- section 15 o

"(i-a) the Pro-Vice-Chancellor;".

5. In the said Act, in section 26, after clause (i), the following shall be inserted: section 26 or

6. In the said Act, after section 28, the following shall Insertion of section be inserted:-

28-A in Sind Act III of 1977.

"28 -A. (1) The Chancellor may in "Pro-Vice-Chancellor. consultation with the Vice-Chancellor, appoint a Pro-Vice-Chancellor for the main campus or for additional campus, if any, or for both the campuses jointly or separately, on such terms and conditions and for such period not exceeding four years at a time as the Chancellor may determine.

Where a Pro-Vice Chancellor is appointed (2)under sub-section (1), he shall, notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, exercise such powers and perform such functions of the Vice-Chancellor or such other powers and functions, in respect of the campus for which he is appointed as the Chancellor may delegate to him.".
