

**SIND ORDINANCE NO. II OF 1988.**

**THE SIND COOPERATIVE HOUSING AUTHORITY (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1988.**

[27<sup>TH</sup> June, 1988]

**AN ORDINANCE** to amend the Sind Cooperative Housing Authority Ordinance, 1982.

**WHEREAS** the Supreme Court of Pakistan has directed to make certain amendment in the Sind Co-operative Housing Authority Ordinance, 1982; **Preamble.**

**AND WHEREAS** it is expedient to amend the Sind Co-operative Housing Authority Ordinance, 1982, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

**AND WHEREAS** the Provincial Assembly is not in session and the Governor of Sind is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action ;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 128 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of Sind is please to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :—

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Co-operative Housing Authority (Amendment) Ordinance, 1988. **Short title and commencement.**

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Co-operative Housing Authority Ordinance, 1982, in section 6, after sub-section (2), the following new sub-section shall be inserted :— **Amendment of section 6 of Sind Ordinance V of 1982.**

“(2-A) Government shall, before taking action under sub-section (2), afford an opportunity of hearing to the society:

Provided that if, as an emergent measure, taking of immediate action is necessary, such opportunity may be dispensed with, but such opportunity shall be afforded to the society as soon thereafter, as is possible:

Provided further that in a case where such opportunity to the society is duly afforded before the action is taken, Government may pass such interim orders, for preventing the commission of mischief or abuse by the society, as it may deem fir.”.
