SIND ORDINANCE NO. I OF 1987

THE SIND LOCAL GOVERNMENT (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1987

[16th March, 1987]

An Ordinance to amend the Sind Local Government Ordinance, 1979.

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Sind Local Preamble. Government Ordinance, 1979, in the manner hereinafter appearing;

AND WHEREAS the Provincial Assembly is not in session and the Governor of Sind is satisfied that circumstances exists which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 128 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of Sind is pleased to make and promulgate the following Ordinance :-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sind Local Government	Short title and
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1987.	commencement.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Local Government Ordinance, 1979, Amendment in hereinafter referred to as the said Ordinance, in section 10, in sub-section (2) of the proviso to sub-section (2), the fullstop at the end shall be replaced by a colon and thereafter the following provisos shall be added :--1979.

> "Provided further that on supersession of a council under section 58, the person or authority appointed to perform the functions of such council may appoint any member of the Advisory Committee appointed under section 58-A or where no such Committee is appointed any other person to exercise the powers and perform the functions of the Chairman of one or more Panchayats.

> Provided also that a Chairman of Panchayat for a minority community shall be a member of the minority community.".

In the said Ordinance, after section 58, the following 3. new section shall be inserted :--

Insertion of section 58-A in **Sind Ordinance**

"58-A (1) Where any person or authority is XII of 1979. Advisory appointed under sub-section (2) of section 58, Committee. Government may appoint an Advisory Committee consisting of such number of persons as it thinks fit to advise such person or authority.

(2) The Advisory Committee shall meet as often and in such manner as the person or authority deems fit.

(3) A member of the Advisory Committee shall hold office at the pleasure of Government but may at any time resign from member-ship by addressing letter to Government.".
