

SINDH ORDINANCE NO.IV OF 2008.

THE SINDH MINISTERS (SALARIES, ALLOWANCES AND PRIVILEGES) (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 2008.

[29th February, 2008]

An Ordinance to amend the Sind Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975.

WHEREAS it is expedient amend the Sind Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975, in the manner hereinafter appearing; **Preamble.**

AND WHEREAS the Provincial Assembly is not in session and the Governor of Sindh is satisfied that circumstances exist which render it necessary to take immediate action;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 128 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, the Governor of Sindh is please to make and promulgate following Ordinance:-

1. (1) This Ordinance may be called the Sindh Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) (Amendment) Ordinance, 2008. **Short title and commencement.**

2. It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Sind Ministers (Salaries, Allowances and Privileges) Act, 1975, in section 19, after sub-section (5), the following new sub-section shall be added:- **Amendment of section 19 of Sind Act No.VIII of 1975.**

“(6) A person who has remained as Chief Minister or a Minister, as the case may be, shall be entitled to facilities of Government guest house, rest house, circuit house and the Sindh House at Islamabad and Murree, with pick and drop facilities by providing a car during his stay on payment of usual charges to which he was entitled under this Act.”.
