NO SO-CC-CTK AD _:- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Sindh Mollon Pictures Act, 2011, the Government of Sindh are pleased to make the following rules.

1. (1) These rules may be called the Sindh Censorship of Film Short title and Rules, 2014.

commencement.

- (2) They shall come into force at once,
- In these rules, unless there is anything repugnant in the Definitions. subject or context -
 - (a) "Act" means the Sindh Mation Pictures Act, 2011;
 - (b) "applicant" means a person applying for certification of a film for public exhibition under rule 19:
 - (c) "Board" means Sindh Board of Film Censors constituted under section 3:
 - (d) "certificate" means a certificate granted under these rules;
 - (e) "Film Inspector" means a Film Inspector appointed under sub-rule (3) of rule 4;
 - (f) "foreign film" means a film not produced in Pakistan:
 - (g) "form" means a form specified in Schedule-I;
 - (h) "Government" means the Government of Sindh;
 - (ii) "licensed place" means a place in respect of which a license has been granted under sub-section (1) of section 13 for giving of public exhibition by means of cinematograph;
 - (j) "Member" means a Member of the Board:
 - (k) "Penal in relation to a Centre" means a Panel of Members of the Board constituted under sub-rule [2]
 - . (I) "playing time" means the total time spent on the

exhibition of certified film at a licenced place during the year commencing on the 1st day of January;

(m) "Secretary" means the Secretary of the Board appointed under sub-rule (2) of rule 4;

10 (1) An application for certification of a film for public Submission of e-motion shall be supposited to the Board in Form "A" -

- (2) Every application shall be accompanied by
 - the print of the film, including its sound track of speech, songs, music and effects; provided that the print may, with the permission of the Secretary. be submitted forty-eight hours before examination of the film;
 - in the case of a foreign film or a film on video (b) cassette or disc -
 - (i) a copy of the press book and synopsis; provided that the Chairman may if the press book or synopsis is not submitted, direct the applicant to submit it within such period as may be specified by him, or may, in suitable coses, dispense with this requirement;
 - hij original documents, including the import license, customs clearance certificate and bill of lading in respect of that film or any other document to prove that the film has lawfully been imported; provided that in the case of a film imported by a foreign mission in Pakistan, it shall be sufficient if the mode of import is specified; and
 - [iii] on affidavit in Form "B";
 - (iv) foreign supplier's certificate attested by their Chamber of Commerce or registered Association, for lawfully holding valid rights for the film of the territory of Pakistan specifying case, credits and country of origin,
 - in the case of a film is on 35M.M, one typed or printed copy of the credit and full text of songs:
 - a treasury receipt of the fee deposited under the head of account "C-03816-Other Receipt Sale of Publicity Material and Rent Documentaries of Film" of the Board at the rates specified in Schedule-II;
 - an aftidavit in Form-H:

Provided that the provisions of clauses (d) and (e) shall not apply in the case of a film imported by a foreign mission:

Provided further that where examination of an old film is dispensed with, the examination fee and screening fee in respect of such a film shall not be charged.

(3) If the application is not complete, the Secretary may return it to the applicant for completion and re-submission to him alongwith any other information which may be required by

(4) Where a film in respect of which the appeal under section 7 is rejected or a film is declared uncertified by Government under sub-section (2) of section 9, the applicant

may submit such film to the Board for certification in the revised form along with the portions excised therefrom:

Provided that no such application shall be allowed more than once in the case of an imported film and more than twice in the case of a film produced in Pakistan:

Provided further that an application in respect of a film declared uncertified under section 9 shall not be entertained by the Board before the expiry of one year from the date of publication of the notification through which the film was declared uncertified and forward its recommendations to Government for such order in relation thereto as it may think fit.

11. (1) Unless the Board otherwise directs, all films for the Examination and certification of which applications have been submitted to the ratings of films. Board under rule 10 shall be examined by such members as are on the panel representing the Board:

Provided that the films of documentaries, cartoons, advertisement shorts and the like may be examined by the Secretary alongwith a Member of the Board.

- (2) The following shall be the ratings of the films :-
 - U: Universal Audiences (General). The motion picture contains nothing in theme, language. nudity, sex, violence or other matters that, in the view of the Board, would offend parents whose younger children view the film. The U rating is not a "certificate of approval" nor does it signify a "children" film. No nudity, sex scenes or drugs used or present in the motion picture.
 - PG; Parental Guidance. A parental guidance film should be investigated by parents before they get their younger children attend. The parental guidance rating indicates, in the view of the Board, that parents may consider some material unsuitable for their children and the parents should make the decision. There may be some profanity and some depictions of violence but these elements are not deemed so intende as to require that parents be strongly cautioned beyond the suggestion of parental guidance and there is no drug use content in a parental auidance rated film.
 - Parental Guidance-13 (Parents cautioned) There may be some material that were be inappropriate for children under the age of thirteen. A PG-13 rating is a stemer warning to parents by the Board to deterrane whether their children under the age of 13 should well the , motion picture, as some materia, may not be

sulfable for them. PG-13 rates motion picture generally shall not be sexually or ented and there may be depictions of violence in ag-13 film but generally not both readistic and extreme or persistent violence.

- PG-15: Parents strongly cautioned. A PG-15 motion picture contains some abut marerial and requires accompanying curem or adult guardian. A PG-15 motion picture may include adult themes, adult activity, thata anguage, intense or persistent violence arug abuse or other elements so that parents are counselled to take this rating very seriously. Critures, under the age of 15 are not allowed to attend PG-15 motion pictures unaccompanied by a parent or adult guardian.
- (v) 18+(Adults). An 18+(A) rated mation picture is one that, in the view of the Board, most parents would consider patently too laguit for their children 18 and under. The 18+(A) rating is appropriately only for adult audience and can be based on violence, sex, aperrational behaviour, drug abuse or any other element that most parents would consider too strong and thereof off-limits for viewing by their children.

12. On receipt of an application under rule 11, the Secretary Fixation of time, shall, in consultation with the Chairman, fix, the date, time and place etc. for place for the examination of the film by such members as may examination of be specified by the Chairman and shall give at least three days films. clear natice thereof to each such Member:

Provided that the Chairman may, in cases of urgency, fix the examination at a short notice.

The applicant shall, if ne has not already deposited the Deposit, print or print of the film alongwith the application, deposit it with the DCP for Secretary atleast forty-eight hours before the time fixed for the examination. examination and, if he fails to do so, the application and the

screening fee deposited by him shall be forfeited to the Board.

The members examining the film shall report to the Board Members their views on whether the film is -

- (a) suitable for un-restricted public exhibition:
- (b) suitable for family exhibition:
- (c) suitable for unrestricted public exhibition as recorded on video cassette, disc of DCP;
- (d) suitable for public exhibition under parental guidance (PG) as recorded on video cassette, disc or DCP:
- (e) suitable for public exhibition after excision of the portions specified;
- (f) suitable for public exhibition restricted to ages eighteen and above; or
- (g) sultable for restricted exhibition to ages eighteen and above as recorded on video tape, disc or
- (h) not suitable for public exhibition.

16. (1) On receipt of a report under rule 16, the Secretary shall, Board to grant as soon as may be; place it before the Board, and the Board certificate. shall pass such orders as it thinks fit:

Provided that the Board may, before possing any order. itself examine the film or have it examined again by any other member of the Board.

- (2) If the Board considers a film to be -
 - (a) suitable for unrestricted public exhibition, orders for the grant of a certificate under the mark "U", shall be
 - (a) suitable for family exhibition, craes for the grant of a certificate in form "E", shall be passed,
 - (c) suitable for public exhibition under parent guidance as recorded on video tape, disc or DCP, orders for the grant of a certification in form "PG" shall be passed; and
 - (d) suitable for unrestricted public exhibition as recorded on video tape or disc, orders for the grant of a certificate in form "U" snat be passed;
 - te) suitable for public exhibition restricted to ages eighteen and above, orders for the grant of a certificate in form "A" shall be passed:

- (f) suitable for restricted exhibition to ages eighteen and above as recorded on video table or disc, orders for grant of a certificate in form " +" shall be passea;
 - (g) suitable for public exhibition after excision of the portions specified by the Board, orders for the grant of a certificate in appropriate form shall be passed subject to such excisions; and
 - (h) not suitable for public exhibition, grant of certificate may be refused and applicant be informed. accordingly:

Provided that the Board may, before refusing to grant a certificate, give the applicant an opportunity of being heard.

- (3) When passing an order for the grant of a certificate, the Board shall specify the area or areas in respect of which, and the period, not exceeding twenty five years in respect of local films only, for which, the certificate shall be valid, but in respect of imported films the certificate shall be issued for the period as may be mutually agreed by and between the importer and producer of a film.
- (4) When in relation to the certificate of a film the period has expired, a fresh certificate may be issued on an application made in this behalf under rule 10 and the same sholl be dealt with as a fresh application:

Provided that the Secretary may with the prior approval of the Board, dispense with examination of the film if the application is for the issue of certificate in the same form in which it was certified earlier:

Provided further that where the examination of an old film is dispensed with, the examination fee and screening fee in respect of such a film shall not be charged.

- (5) The orders of the Board sholl be communicated to the application by the Secretary in writing.
- 17. (1) If the applicant communicates to the Secretary his Issue of acceptance in writing to the grant of a certificate for certificate unrestricted public exhibition of the film, or as the case may be, public exhibition restricted to ages eighteen and above only, a certificate only shall be issued to him in the appropriate form.

- (2) If the applicant communicates to the Secretary his acceptance in writing to the grant of a certificate for public exhibition of the film subject to the specified excision, a certificate in the appropriate form shall be issued to him subject to other provisions of these rules.
 - (3) Before a certificate is issued under sub-rule (2) -
 - (a) the applicant shall
 - carry out, or cause to be carried out, by a Film Inspector, all excisions specified by the Board
 - surrender the excised portions to the Board; and
 - (iii) make a declaration in form "E" and
 - (b) the Secretary, by examining the film Himself or having it examined by a film inspector, shall verify that the excisions have been carried out in accordance with the directions of the Boara.

(4) If the applicant does not communicate his acceptance to the issuance of the certificate, subject to the excisions within a period of fifteen days from the date of the receipt of the orders of the Board, the application shall be rejected:

Provided that the Board may, in special case, extend the time and period not exceeding three months.

- (i) if it relates to any film passed for public exhibition after excision, bear a clearly visible triangle drawn at the left hand bottom corner and an endorsement stating the description of the portions excised and surrendered to the Board with their exact length alonawith the observation of the Board, if any:
- (j) if it relates to a film foreign mission for exhibition at private gatherings, bear a subber stamp to the effect

that the film is for non-commercial and non-theatrical exhibition by that mission;

- (k) specify the area or areas within which, and the period for which, the certificate is valid;
- be signed by the Chairman, or in his absence, the Vice Chairman and in absence of both, the Secretary of the concerned Department, Covernment of Sindh shall authorize Secretary of the Board to sign the

The lawful owner of a certified film, or a person duly Duplicate authorized by him, may request the Board for a duplicate Certificate. certificate, and the Board may, on production of a treasury receipt of fee of Rs.1000/- naving been deposited in the treasury, issue a duplicate certificate to such owner.

Where any film has been certified for public exhibition. Surrender of subject to any excision any person who, after the issue of the excised portions certificate, imports or otherwise acquires a copy of that film from copies of shall surrender to the Board such portions from such copy as certified film later were excised from that film:

Provided that all subsequently imported or acquired prints of a certified film shall be submitted to the Board for verification.

- 22. (1) Record of certification of film shall be preserved by the Preservation and Board for a minimum period of twelve years from the date of disposal of certification of the film and shall be destroyed thereafter in such record of films manner as the Board may direct.
 - and the excised portions thereof.
- (2) The excised portions surrendered to the Board under these rules shall be preserved for a period of thirty days from the date of their surrender to the Board, and shall be destroyed thereafter in such manner as the Board may direct.
- 23. [1] If after certification, a film is aftered by excision, addition Certified films or otherwise, it shall cease to be a certified film and shall not be later altered to exhibited unless it has been examined by the Board on receipt be certified of an application in form "F" and a fresh certificate issued in afresh. respect thereof in accordance with these rules."

(2) On receipt of an application under sub-rule (1), the Board shall examine or have it examined, at the expense of the applicant, the film or the reel or reels in which the alterations occur:

Provided that examination fee chargeable in respect of an altered film shall, notwithstanding the fact that the entire film is examined afresh, be calculated with reference to the reel or reels in which the alterations occur.

(3) The title of the film shall not be changed.

24. [1] If Government or the Board requires under section 11 any Power of certified film to be exhibited, the Board may direct any person who is for the time being in possession of any print of that film to deliver it to the Board, and shall inform the lawful owner of the film of such directions, and the person to whom such direction is given or the lawful owner thereof shall deliver the print within such period as may be specified by the Board.

Government and Board to recall certified film for exhibition.

(2) If the film is not delivered to the Board with the specified period, the Board or, as the case may be, Government, shall take such action under the Act as it thinks lit.

Where Government directs under sub-section (6) of Surrender of section 8 or 9 a certified film to be deemed to be an uncertified certificate of film for the whole of the area in respect of which the certificate -uncertified films. is valid, the person who is in lawful possession of the certificate shall surrender it and all copies thereof to the Board within such period as the Board may direct:

Provided that the Board may, at the request of such person, extend the said period not exceeding three months.

26. (1) Any person advertising a film certified for public Advertisement of exhibition restricted to ages eighteen and above only or publishing such film by means of insertion in newspapers. posters and hand bills shall, after the certificate in respect of and above only. that film has been issued, indicate in such insertion that the film has been certified for public exhibition restricted to ages eighteen and above only.

(2) The name of film and its publicity shall be strictly in accordance with the title as certified and no local translation of the name of the film from English or any other language shall be

allowed into Urdu or any other regional language. 27. (1) The prescribed mark of the Board shall be a film copy of Prescribed mark

the certificate issued by the Board and affixed to a certified of the Board.

[2] The prescribed mark shall be affixed to the film to which it relates, and shall always be exhibited with the film:

Provided that in the case of a film of foreign mission meant for non-commercial and non-theatrical exhibition, such mark need not be affixed to the film, but the mission shall, on demand, show the certificate to any officer or any member authorized by the Board.

(3) The length of the prescribed mark shall be in respect of a certified film of 35 M.M. not less than five meters; and

If the Board, on an application made to it in this behalf, is of the opinion that any film is of a purely education character, it shall refund to the applicant the examination fee deposited by him.

Refund of examination fee in respect of educational

For the purpose of inspection, a copy of the certificate, duty issued by the Board on payment of Rs.10/- per copy in the Government treasury, shall be kept at licensed place at which the film is being exhibited.

30. (1) The owner or proprietor of a licensed place at which Playing time. foreign films were, during the year immediately before the commencement of these rules, being exhibited for not less than fifty percent of its playing time shall, if the Deputy Commissioner's Office within whose jurisdiction the licensed place is located so certifies, exhibit films produced in Pakistan for not less than fifty percent of its playing time and may, during the rest of playing time, exhibit foreign films other than such foreign films as are in any of the Pakistani or Indian language and depict the Pakistani or Indian way of life,

(2) The owner or proprietor of a licensed place in respect of which the certificate referred to in sub-rule (1) has not been obtained within a period of thirty days from the commencement of these rules shall exhibit at such place Pakistani films for not less than eighty five percent of its playing time, and may, during the rest of the playing time, exhibit foreign films, other than such to eign films as are in any of the Pakistan or Indian language and depict a Pakistani or Indian way of life.

- (3) The decision of Gavernment as to whether a particular certified film is or is not a Pakstaru film, or is or is not, a foreign film in any of the Pakistoni or Indian language or depicts the Pakistan or Indian way of life shall be final.
- (4) Every owner or proprietor of a licensed place shall submit to the Deputy Commissioner such return relating to the utilization of the playing time at that place and such interval as the Deputy Commissioner may specify.
- (5) The Deputy Commissioner shall forward the return received by him under sub-rule (4) to Government.
- 31. The duties of a Film Inspector shall be -

Duties of Film Inspectors.

- to make outdoor checks for the purpose of ensuring that the provisions of the Act and these rules are being observed in the Cinema Houses, and to report to the Chairman, Vice-Chairman or the Secretary if any of such provisions is being violated; and
- to do any other work that may from time to time be entrusted to him by the Chairman, Vice-Chairman or , the Secretary.
- 32. (1) All Officers and members of the Board, Members of the Authorized Appellate Committee, Honorary Film Inspectors and Officers' person to enter dealing with the administration of the Act, authorized in writing licensed place by the Board may enter any licensed place for the purpose for for inspection. ensuring that no provision of the Act, or these rules, or no condition subject to which the certificate was granted, is being contravened, and, in case of any contravention, shall bring such contravention to the notice of the Board?

- (2) The owner or manager of the licensed place shall provide the person referred to in sub-rule (1) two seats of the highest class without payment of admission fee or any tax to enable him to view the film.
- The Board shall submit to Government, in the month of Submission of January every year, an annual report on the business conducted by the Board during the preceding year.

The Secretary shall maintain a register in which the Register of films. following particulars of films shall be entered, namely:-

- (a) the name, exact length and number of reels of every films for the certification of which applications have been received;
- (b) the name of the country, in which the film was originally produced:

- (d) the name of the person or firm producing or releasing

- (g) the result of the examination and any further proceedings thereon;
- (h) the number, date and category of the certificate issued, if any, together with a copy of any endorsement made on the certificate; and
- (i) remarks.

(2) Every film in respect of which an appeal is preferred shall be examined by an Appellate Committee set up by

Government consisting of not less than -

- (a) three officers not below the rank of BPS-20;
- (b) three persons who are not in Government service.
- (3) The meetings of the Appellate Committee shall be presided over by the Chairman elected by members attending the meeting from amongst the members appointed under clause (a) of sub-rule (2).
- (4) Immediately after the examination of the film, the members of the Appellate Committee shall record their views stating clearly whether they agree with the views of the Board or not, and the report of the Committee shall be submitted to
- (2) The presence of at least three members of the Appellate Committee shall be necessary to constitute a quorum for the purposes of examination of the film, and the report of the Committee shall bear the signature of at least three of its
- (3) In case the Appellate Committee disagrees with the findings of the Board, the reasons for such disagreement shall also be given in the report.
- (4) The decision of Government taken ofter consideration of the report of the Appellate Committee shall be communicated to the Appellant and, for compliance to the Board.
- The provisions of the Censorship of Films Rules, 1980. Repeal. relating to the Province of Sindh are hereby repealed.
